The Inclusive Design Challenge (IDC) is a prize competition that awards innovative ideas and design solutions to enable persons with disabilities to use automated vehicles independently, both now and in the future. Academic, research, and business communities are invited to compete for a total prize purse of \$5 million.

The IDC is intended to inspire inclusive designs for automated vehicles as they are developed, as well as increase universal access for conventional vehicles for persons with physical, sensory, and/or cognitive disabilities.
